Both floors of the building have wheelchair access and accessible facilities.

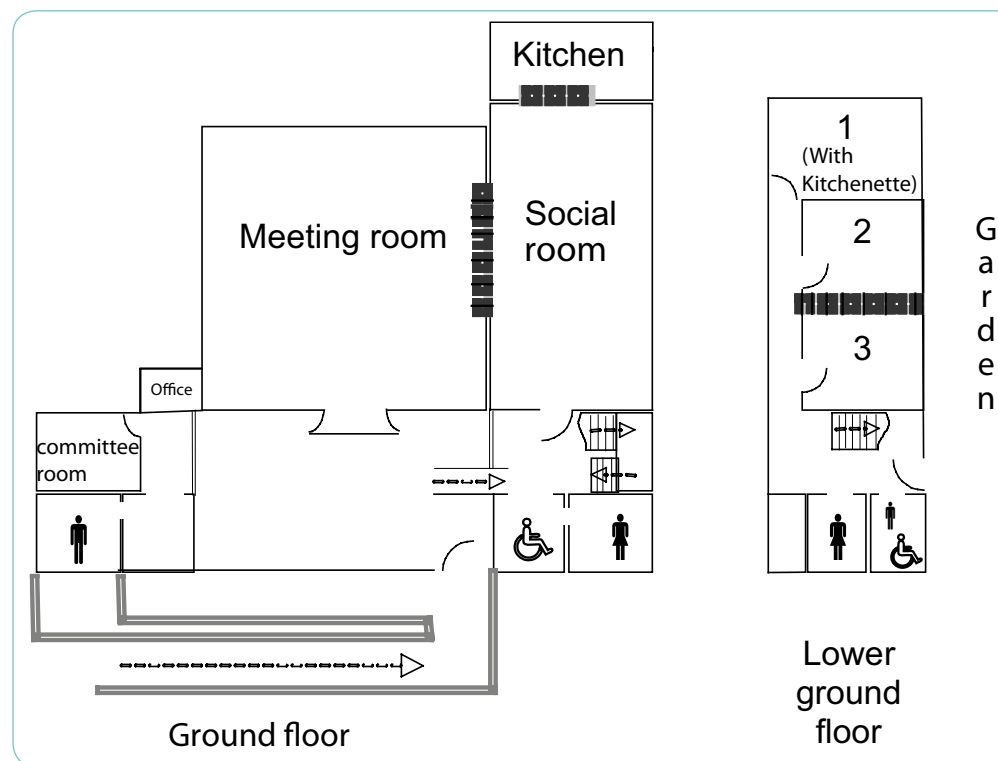

# How to find us...

We are a five-minute walk from the Market Square and easily accessible by...



## Tram

Trams run from the train station and the Forest park and ride. The meeting house is a short walk up Chaucer Street from the Trent University stop.



## Bus

Several bus routes go up Derby Road and down Talbot Street and Wollaton Street crossing Clarendon Street.



## Car

Parking on Clarendon Street is free on Sundays and metered Monday to Saturday, including bank holidays, with a maximum two hour stay. There are multi-storey car parks on Talbot Street and Wollaton Street.



## Terms and conditions

Please refer to the booking form for full terms and conditions of use.

A non-refundable 10% deposit is payable on confirmation of booking. The right is reserved to refuse any bookings and to discontinue series bookings.

Cancellation charges are as follows.

- 14 or more days' written notice: deposit only.
- Between 13 and 7 days' notice: 50%.
- Less than 7 days' notice: full charge.

The Meeting House is not responsible for damage to, or loss of, hirers' property.
